

KEY HIGHLIGHTS – Tanzania

This one-pager aims to provide a brief overview of the most salient features of Tanzania’s national cooperative landscape, based on the detailed input provided by the ICA membership.

Tanzania counts one ICA member organization, the Tanzania Federation of Cooperatives (TFC). TFC is a national cooperative umbrella organization that promotes, serves and coordinates the development and prosperity of all cooperative societies in mainland Tanzania.

The data below was gathered through compiling the member’s replies to a common questionnaire. For further information, readers are invited to check the methodology in the full report section.

The following figures have been compiled based on the ICA member’s data relative to their own member organisations:

In addition, the national statistics total on registered cooperatives as at the close of 2019 are:

- A total of 11,629 registered cooperatives in Mainland Tanzania, and 4,751 in Zanzibar Tanzania
- The cooperatives in Mainland Tanzania provide direct employment to 90,090 people.
